**2025 THE JUBILEE:** The Holy Father has decided that 2025 will be a Year of Jubilee, something which happens every 25 years. Tradition dictates that each Jubilee is proclaimed through the publication of a Papal (or Pontifical) 'Bull of Indiction.' (*Spes non Confundit; Hope Does Not Disappoint,* is the Bull of Indiction of the Ordinary Jubilee of the Year 2025 see:

https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/bulls/documents/20240509\_spes-non-confundit\_bolla-giubileo2025.html). By 'Bull' is meant an official document, generally written in Latin, bearing the seal of the Pope, the shape of which gives its name to the document itself. The theme of the Jubilee Year is "Pilgrims of Hope," and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering

The theme of the Jubilee Year is "Pilgrims of Hope," and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of COVID – 19 pandemic and other moral and spiritual crises in the world today. Preparations for the 2025 Year of Jubilee began in Advent 2023, which marked the start of a Year of Prayer. Alive Publishing have produced a Companion Booklet with prayers and reflections based around the theme of hope and Jubilee themes found in the Scriptures.
