A REFLECTION FROM POPE FRANCIS FOR THE YEAR OF PRAYER, ON THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT: To God who blesses, we too respond by blessing — God has taught us how to bless and we must bless — through the prayer of praise, of adoration, of thanksgiving.
